Full itinerary:

Day 1 – INTRODUCTION TO SKADAR LAKE HINTERLANDS

Make sure to pack your bags this morning as you'll be heading straight after work to a little piece of paradise in Skadar Lake hinterlands. There you'll find lush greenery, plenty of delicious organic food, and the soothing sound of bird chirping. Since you'll be staying in a famous wine region, dinner will be served with degustation of local wines.

Day 2 - ONE OF A KIND ADVENTURE



Start the day with a visit to an old stone village, almost abandoned after the dreadful earthquake back in 1979. Listen to the story of the area by local guide followed with drive by the lake shore all the way to one of the islands. Get into the kayaks and head to the island with medieval monastery and nuns who will tell you their story and history of the place and the area. Unique experience. End the day on a high note – wine tasting in a small local winery in this region comes as a must.

Accommodation – questhouse Skadar Lake area 3* (b&b).

Day 3 - IS TIME TRAVEL POSSIBLE?

Starting early to get to see the best of the birdlife. Skadar Lake National Park is the zone where there are over 280 different bird species, with special accent to Dalmatian Pelican, that is also nesting on the Lake. Private lake cruise coloured with water lilies and water caltrops will landscape our way through a small jungle like channels on the route to the island monastery. Passing between "Goat and Sheep Islands", we will reach the pristine part of the lake where you will hear bird and frogs fighting over the title "singer of the day".



Afternoon is reserved for a road trip - the old road from one ancient marketplace to another, special ride before arriving to a delicious fish meal.



*Special Option: For a road trip like you have never tried before — taking you back in time, this ride can be featured in a vintage restored Fiat 500 from 1973, back in the days most popular car in Yugoslavia. A ride during which you'll learn about great historical importance of both Virpazar and Rijeka Crnojevića (for 2 people maximum).

After the lunch head home with fully recharged batteries.
